



SECTION 4. CARBURETOR DISASSEMBLY

You will need the following tools:

1. #2 phillips screw driver
2. Solvent and a soft brush
3. A rag for wiping up possible residual gasoline

WARNING:

- * Gasoline is flammable, dispose of it properly
- * Always wear gloves when working with gasoline or other solvents

1 Carburetor Disassembly

- 1.1 Remove the Carburetor from the mower (Refer to Section 3.)
- 1.2 Clean the outside of the Carburetor with a solvent and a soft brush

2 Removing the Bowl

- 2.1 Remove the screws holding on the bottom of the carburetor (the bowl)
- 2.2 Remove the bowl and be careful not to get any debris inside the carburetor.
Note: (residual gasoline may still be inside the carburetor and will probably spill at this point)
- 2.3 Gently pull out the floats and the pivot bar they are attached to.

3 Removing the Mixing Cover

- 3.1 Remove the screws that hold the top part of the carburetor on (The Mixing Cover).
- 3.2 Remove the mixing cover itself by sliding it vertically until the assembly is clear of the carburetor.

NOTE: ASSEMBLY IS THE REVERSE OF DISASSEMBLY.
